

TESTEX is pleased to announce that the first textile mask with the «TESTEX Community Mask» label is now available in conjunction with Swiss companies Jakob Schlaepfer, Forster Rohner AG and Schoeller Textil AG.

The «Swiss National COVID-19 Science Task Force» has developed a set of recommendations and defined what requirements textile masks should meet. Together with Empa, TESTEX has refined a testing procedure whereby textile masks are being evaluated on these recommended requirements for their filter function, splash resistance, wear comfort, reusability and additionally, their innocuousness. The label includes STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® certification, which ensures that the masks have been tested for harmful substances. For more information please visit:
